Dudley's Big Switch

After the pricey festive season, now is a perfect time to be thinking about saving on your home gas and electricity bills.

Dudley Council is urging people to sign up to its latest Big Switch energy switching scheme. The scheme offers householders market leading deals on home energy not available elsewhere. Average savings per household of up to £300 per year have been made by people signing up to the scheme.

Signing up is simple - either contact Dudley Council Plus who will guide you through the process, or sign up online.

In previous auctions more than 6000 people across Dudley have registered to switch to enjoy the potential of the great savings on offer. Since the scheme began in June 2013 the collective savings made by borough residents has topped £520,000 and if everyone had proceeded to switch, savings would have reached £1.5 million.

The Big Switch is open now and closes for registrations on 13th February. To take advantage of the cut price rates offered by energy companies call 0300 555 2345 or visit www.dudley.gov.uk/bigswitch.

The scheme is open to all householders, including people living in rented accommodation and people with a prepayment meter.
