Dudley Winter Warmth Scheme

Dudley Council's winter warmth support scheme which helpedmore than eight hundred residents keep warm and well in their homes last winterhas been launched once again for the coming winter and will now continue to runthroughout the year.

The scheme aims to help people struggling to keep theirhomes and themselves warm enough during the winter months. Householders cansave significantly on their home energy bills with the right advice onappropriate tariffs, as well as energy discounts and grants.

A variety of practical support, information and expertadvice is provided through the scheme. Anyone worried about keeping their homewarm this winter, struggling with paying their fuel bills or concerned aboutkeeping well at home during the winter due to the cold can ask for help fromthe scheme.

All sorts of help can be provided from expert advice and support with changing to the best energy provider and tariff, help with energydebt, as well as assistance with home energy efficiency improvements and grants, including access to free boiler and home insulation schemes.

Councillor Les Jones, cabinet member for housing, said:

"Each year people die as a result of freezing winter weatherand cold homes. Living in a cold home can lead to very serious health problems, particularly for older people, young children and people suffering from longterm health conditions, such as asthma.

"It is essential that people start preparing for winterbefore the cold months set in. If peopleare concerned about heating their homes they should contact the

scheme'shelpline to ask for support and advice. We want to make sure that all ourresidents keep warm and well in their homes whatever the time of year – hencethe extension of the scheme to all year round. I encourage anyone concernedabout keeping warm at home themselves, or worried about a relative, friend orneighbour, to call the scheme."

Web pages you enter personal or financial details into should display a locked padlock sign and have a web address that starts with https. This means your connection to the website is secure.

Phishing

Don't click on links or attachments within unsolicited emails. The number of online shopping related phishing emails increases significantly during the holiday period.





Bank transfers

65% of Action Fraud reports during the 2016 Christmas period were linked to online auction sites. Don't pay for goods or services by bank transfer unless you know and trust the person.


