Main items from DFTRA General Meeting Thursday 29th March 2018

- New DFTRA Directors: Tony Brain (Hill Street 3 Towers TRA), Elaine Lloyd (Ellowes Hall & Area TRA), George McClay (Beacon Hill TRA) were welcomed to the Board officially after their registration at Companies House.
- Community Forum funding: The procedure is due to be reviewed later in the year and groups will be updated once more is known.
- Lettings: Sian Evans explained that consultation around Low Rise properties is currently being carried out. This is due to a difference in the demand for properties and the availability of suitable properties for the people who need them (i.e. more properties for older people than younger people).
