Free Live4Less courses offer tips, techniques and practical advice about how to manage your money, including...


- Making budget savings

Sleigh no to loan sharks this Christmas!

Christmas brings joy and family celebrations, but the cost of gifts, food, and parties can add up, creating financial strain leaving some people vulnerable to loan sharks.

Loan sharks are illegal lenders who often seem friendly, they could be a neighbor, colleague, or family friend. Borrowers may not realize the danger until it's too late. A small loan can spiral into huge debt, as these lenders aren't regulated, charge excessive interest and may use threats or violence if you can't pay.
