Partnership Update

The subject of Carbon Monoxide (CO) detectors has been discussed various times at our General Meetings. We recently asked Dudley Council to provide answers as to why detectors were being fitted in some properties and not others, here is the response:

Dudley Council as an organisation currently only fit CO detectors to existing homes based on a "risk assessment".

Most of the boilers fitted within our homes are now of the "fail safe" types of appliance, and we therefore believe that these do not need a CO detector fitted adjacent to them. We still have some open flued appliances such as back boilers which have been risk assessed and as a result our policy is to fit a CO detector adjacent to these appliances but only where they are located in a "high risk" area e.g. within bedrooms.

Only when we are made aware that a resident is sleeping in a room as a temporary measure that has an open flued appliance e.g. back boiler, will we fit a CO detector. We also ensure that the property is added to our database highlighting that a safety check (and service if required), are undertaken on a six monthly basis until such a time as the room is returned to its normal use.

Training opportunities

Don't forget, it's not just the necessary training for officer roles that can be done through the <u>Participation Development Team</u>. If you or your TRA members feel that certain training will enable you to further your role on the committee, let them know!
